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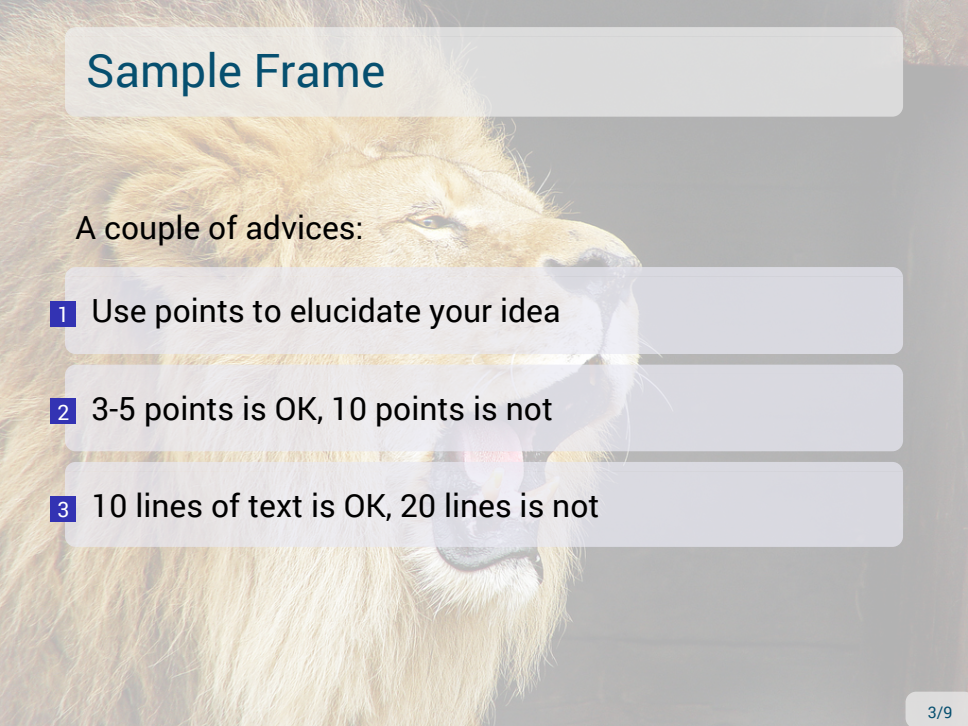

Sample Frame



A couple of advices:

- 1 Use points to elucidate your idea
- 2 3-5 points is OK, 10 points is not
- 3 10 lines of text is OK, 20 lines is not

Other Sample Frame

Use blocks to emphasize some points

Very famous Einstein's equation

$$E = mc^2$$

describes mass–energy equivalence

Use **colors** for this same reason, e.g.

“The electron is an **elementary particle** with a negative **elementary electric charge**. Electron is a **lepton**.”

$$i\hbar \frac{d\Phi}{dt} = \hat{H}\Phi$$

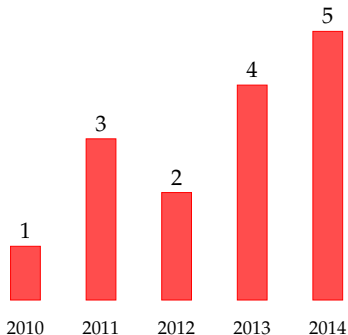


Figure : Lion.
